

Clown Loach (*Chromobotia macracanthus*)



Did you know Clown Loaches can grow to 12" (30cm)?
That cute little 1.5" Clown can even reach 15" in the wild.

.....
Clown loaches are highly social creatures and must be kept in groups.

A minimum of 5 is recommended so the fish may feel secure.
The minimum tank size that should be contemplated for a group is
75 gallons. A group of adult Clowns will require a minimum tank of
6 feet x 2 x 2, with high turnover filtration and frequent water
changes. As Clowns may live as long as 40 years, choosing to keep
them is a commitment to care that is much longer than for a dog.
